

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

July 23, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Adam Munguia called the public session to order at 7:00 pm at the Epping Town Hall.

DISCUSSION WITH W&S COMMISSIONERS

Chairman Munguia started the meeting with opening remarks, thanking the W&S Commission for their years of service. Mr. Munguia explained this is a fact finding meeting with an attempt to solicit information from the Water and Sewer Commission. He feels there are problems to solve and the boards are accountable only to the voters. A lengthy discussion occurred with comments/concerns/views/opinions that can be viewed on ETV or a DVD.

Motion by Selectman Belanger to move forward with a special meeting to dissolve the Water and Sewer Commission. Seconded by Selectman Yergeau for discussion. After continuing to debate the pros and cons of how to fix the issues stated in the Water and Sewer Department, Selectman Yergeau rescinded his second of the motion. The motion failed due to lack of a second.

Motion by Selectman Dwyer to keep the Water and Sewer Commission intact with the stipulation the new commissioner would be recommended by the August 13th meeting at the Board of Selectmen or the Board of Selectmen will appoint a commissioner at the August 27th meeting. Seconded by Selectman Munguia. Motion carried 4-1-0. Selectman Belanger voted any.
